1. Entry closes: 24 October 2019
2. Entry fees are
  - a. Single 5,00 Euro
  - b. Administration fee 4,00 Euro
  - c. Sales ticket (show class) 2,50 Euro
  - d. Catalogue (min. 1 per family obligated) 6,00 Euro
  - e. Transit cage 2,50 Euro each
  - f. Sales section 5 Euro each
3. Participating

Entries are accepted for adults and youth (4-18) breeders, who are member of a federation which is member of the EE. Accepted are Sussex, Orpington, Dorking, Sussexbantam, Orpingtonbantam en Dorkingbantam in all colors that are accepted by any of the federations who are member of the EE.
4. Admissible are:
  - a. Single entries
5. Marking of animals all animals exhibited must be marked with authorized markings of a country connected to the EE. For the markings, the requirements of the individual countries, which are connected to the EE, shall apply.
6. Compulsory vaccination against Pseudo-avian influenza (NCD)

Each submission must be accompanied by a copy of the vaccination statement. The vaccination declaration must be completed in the manner laid down and shall bear the signature of the owner of the animals and of the veterinarian who carried out the vaccination and the date of the vaccination. The vaccination declarations must be handed at Tiel and will not be returned to the contributor at the end of the show. Animals without an vaccination declaration are not allowed.
7. Submitting the Registration Form

The registration forms must be sent/emailed to the aforementioned address. The registration forms must be filled in clearly, in block letters and in one of the three EE

languages (German, French or English). (Except for Dutch). After registration changes can no longer be processed after the closing date.

8. Payment

The payment of the entry fee should normally be paid up to 10 days after the closing date. The payment should preferably be made by bank transfer, but payment in cash during the show is also possible but is not preferred.

9. Show results catalogue

The catalogue is obligatory for each contributor. At least 1 catalogue per family.

10. Sales

The buying and selling of exhibited birds is possible on 15 November 2019 from 17.00 hours to 19.00 hours and on 16 November 2019 from 9.30 hours to 17.00 hours. Each contributor has the right to offer his/her animals for sale. One must buy a sales ticket for this. The selling price must be indicated in Euro. The seller receives 100% of the specified sales price. The seller pays an amount of €2.50 per sales card. Sold animals may be boxed and taken on Saturday 16 November 2019 from 17.00 – 18.00 hours. The money from the sold animals (100% of the indicated selling price) is by the contributor during the show to pick up in the exhibition room (Secretariat).

11. Out of competition cages

For €2.50 Euro per cage number, each contributor can reserve additional cages for animals intended for a colleague breeder who are optimally cared for during the duration of the exhibition. These animals outside competition may also be offered for sale in an open sales class at 5 euros per animal (cage + sales card).

12. Euro-Champion (single animals)

The title "Europa-Champion" can be given according to the following conditions:

- a. For at least 20 reported animals per breed, the title "Europa-Champion" is awarded. The best animal is determined independently of the genus.
- b. As soon as at least 20 animals have been reported per separate color, an additional Euro Champion will be awarded, irrespective of the gender.
- c. As soon as at least 40 animals per breed have been reported, a Euro Champion is awarded for the best Male animal and for the best female animal. This also applies to the separate color strokes that meet this condition (40 animals per separate color).
- d. The title is given only at a predicate of at least 'very good' 95 points. If There are several animals that qualify with equal predicate, then the title is awarded by the Chief judge, in collaboration with a judge group with at least 2 additional judges of different nationality.
- e. The best animal per breed receives an EE medal from the European Entente.

13. Euro Master (per collection)

- a. The title " Euro Master " for collections is given when at least 20 animals have been reported per breed. If at least 20 Animals Have been reported per color stroke, an additional title will also be awarded.
- b. The Europameister title is calculated from the total of points per contributor of the 4 best animals in the same color stroke. Both sexes must be represented. If multiple collections achieve the same highest score, they are all awarded the title.

14. Breakfast at the exhibition hall

For contributors who stay in the vicinity on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays the possibility is offered to have breakfast for 5 euros per person in the cafeteria of the exhibition hall. Registration is required.

15. Evening meal on Friday

Also for Friday evening you can register for 10 euros to take part in a joint supper in the cafeteria of the show ground. A Chinese buffet will be provided.

16. Breeders Evening including the award ceremony

On Saturday evening from 19h30 there is a breeder's evening arranged in "the Avezaten" Daver 46 4012BC Kerk-Avezaath at about 5km from the showground. For 35 Euro per person you can take part in this festive evening with buffet and all drinks included. We offer all awards and finish with live music.

17. Advertising, animal photography

In The exhibition hall, the placing of advertisements is only permitted if permission has been given by the organization. Official animal photographers must collect a written declaration from the organization. This statement is only provided to accredited photographers of professional journals. The requests for accreditation must be sent to the organization. The time for photographing determined the organization. For visitors it is forbidden to open the exhibition cages to photographs.

18. Guidelines General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

In order to protect your privacy, the contributors are required to provide their name and address details in the catalogue and for publication of photos, etc. The permission will automatically be given to you with your registration.
