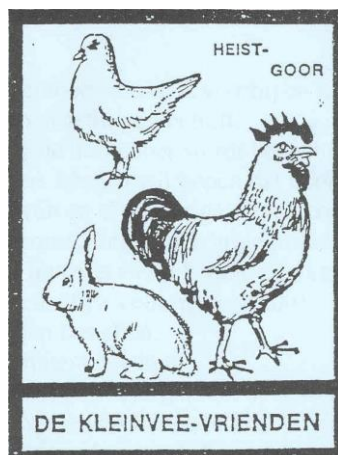

1. Entry closes: 7 October 2024
2. Entry fees are:
 - a. Single 6,00 Euro
 - b. Administration fee 4,00 Euro
 - c. Catalogue (min. 1 per family obligated) 6,00 Euro
3. Participating
Entries are accepted for adults and youth (4-18) breeders, who are member of a federation which is member of the EE. Accepted are Sussex, Orpington, Dorking, Sussex bantam, Orpington bantam en Dorking bantam, young and old, in all colours that are accepted by any of the federations who are member of the EE.
4. Admissible are only single entries.
5. Marking of animals:
All animals exhibited must be marked with authorized markings of a country connected to the EE. For the markings, the requirements of the individual countries, which are connected to the EE, shall apply.
6. Compulsory vaccination against Pseudo-avian influenza (NCD)
Each submission must be accompanied by a copy of the vaccination statement. The vaccination declaration must be completed in the manner laid down and shall bear the signature of the owner of the animals and of the veterinarian who carried out the vaccination and the date of the vaccination. The vaccination declarations should preferably be sent together with the entries, they must at the latest be handed in Putte and will not be returned to the contributor at the end of the show. Animals without a vaccination declaration are not allowed.

7. Document for cross-border transport:
Dutch, Luxembourg and French entrants can submit the animals with a "self-declaration – Article 139". For shipments from all other European countries, an animal health certificate (TRACES) is required.
These documents must be issued together with the vaccination certificate for NCD when the birds are delivered. More detailed information can be found on www.nsodc.eu
8. Submitting the Registration Form
The registration forms must be sent/mailed to the aforementioned address. The registration forms must be legible, in block letters and in one of the three EE languages (German, French or English) or Dutch. New registrations and changes cannot be considered after the closing date.
9. Payment
At the same time as registration, please pay the registration fee by bank transfer to account number: IBAN: NL 35 INGB 0004 6037 86 BIC: INGBNL2A in the name of NSODC.
10. Show results catalogue.
The catalogue is obligatory for each contributor. At least 1 catalogue per family.
11. Sales
The birds may not be sold, they must be returned to their place of origin. It is also not possible to purchase birds at the show. A birds sold at the show always needs two documents, one to be transported from home to the show and a second to travel from the show to the customer's home address. That second document would have to be drawn up by a veterinarian of the FASFC at the show itself and that is not feasible.
12. Euro-Champion (single animals)
The title "Europa-Champion" can be given according to the following conditions:
 - a. For at least 20 reported animals per breed, the title "Europa-Champion" is awarded. The best animal is determined independently of the genus.
 - b. As soon as at least 20 animals have been reported per separate color, an additional Euro Champion will be awarded, irrespective of the gender.
 - c. As soon as at least 40 animals per breed have been reported, a Euro Champion is awarded for the best male animal and for the best female animal. This also applies to the separate colors that meet this condition (40 animals per separate color).
 - d. The title is given only at a predicate of at least 'very good' 95 points. If there are several birds that qualify with equal predicate, then the title is awarded by the Chief judge, in collaboration with a judge group with at least 2 additional judges of different nationality.
 - e. The best animal per breed receives an EE medal from the European Entente.
13. Euro Master (per collection)
 - a. The title " Euro Master " for collections is given when at least 20 animals have been reported per breed. If at least 20 Animals Have been reported per color, an additional title will also be awarded.
 - b. The Europameister title is calculated from the total of points per participant of the 4 best animals in the same color. Both sexes must be represented. If multiple collections achieve the same highest score, they are all awarded the title.
14. Breeders evening including the award ceremony
On Saturday evening from 19h30 there is a breeders' evening arranged in "P.M.O. Grasheide" Kerkhoflei 3, 2580 Grasheide at about 7 km from the hall. For 30 euros per person you can participate in this festive evening with buffet. We will award all prizes there and close with music. Drinks will be paid for separately.

15. Advertising, animal photography

In the exhibition hall, the placing of advertisements is only permitted if permission has been given by the organization. Official animal photographers must collect a written declaration from the organization. This statement is only provided to accredited photographers of professional journals. The requests for accreditation must be sent to the organization. The time for photographing is determined by the organization. It is forbidden for visitors to open the exhibition cages to take pictures.

16. General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) guidelines.

To protect your privacy, permission is required from entrants to include their name and address details in the catalogue and for publication of photos, etc. You automatically give permission with your registration.
